i. Agronomy project		
No.	Activities Description	Achievement
1	Provided technical training course on rice production, vegetables planting, compost making and natural pesticide making to farmers in 10 communes of Rumdoul district, Svay Rieng Province, Cambodia.	40 courses with 376 participants and 285 are women
2	Set up model farmers of vegetable cover net, cucumber, long bean, eggplant and agro-ecosystem.	30 families
3	Trained farmer to make the dry compost and natural pesticide to apply vegetable planting.	29 families
4	Cooperated with technical staffs from Provincial Department of Agricultural, Forestry and Fishery of Svay Rieng to provide training, coaching, follow up and technical consulting to target farmers.	4 times
5	Provided and planting the rose trees for environment on pagodas, school and publish land and Expand tree species to lowland people.	431 trees
6	Supported and planted fruit trees for helping environment and increase income for selling its fruits.	180 trees
7	Tree seeding at office to reduce the transport and price.	360 trees
8	Worked follow up, consulted and coached farmers in agronomy activities at their home based.	560 families

1	Provided technical training on livestock and veterinary on raising pig, chicken, duck and fish to target farmers in Rumdoul district of Svay Rieng province.	47 courses with 466 participants and 299 are women
2	Cooperated with the veterinary technical staff of Provincial Department of Agricultural, Forestry and Fishery of Svay Reing to provided training on raising animals, animal disease and how to prevent and treatment and show farmer how to mix feed to reduce investment cost.	4 course with 48 participants and 34 are women
3	Cooperated with the veterinary technical staff of Provincial Department of Agricultural, Forestry and Fishery of Svay Reing provided the training on raising animals, kind disease and how to prevent and treatment on pig, chicken, duck and fish and also show the easy feed mixing method to reduce the investment cost.	2 times with 12 families
4	Farmer meeting and introduce about water fern Azolla for animal feed. It's good for animal, cheap and also easy to plant. This fern is very easy to plant and take care.	51 courses with 514 participants and 333 are women
5	After training and dissemination about water fern Azolla, CAO also provide it's variety to farmer for free, and always follow up and work together with farmer to mix for their animal feed.	6 families equal to 12kg
6	Provided the modern seed of animals grass with high nutrients to farmers to grow for their animals to eat for hold year.	10 families
7	Supported a cow to self-help group of women with good performance of cash saving and meeting.	1 cow
8	Selected and set upped the model of farmer on chicken husbandry with good variety selection and use vaccination.	2 families
9	Passing on a calf after delivery from a cow and raise by a member in self-help group of women. This calf will pass on to another member in the self-help group at its age 18 months old; mean it can eat grass without meal anymore. We set a detail policy in another documents for cow bank.	2 cows
10	Passing on the chicken from the member in self-help group of women after the chicken laying eggs and hatch. So when the	8 chickens

	chicks are growth up they will pass on some chicken to another member and the next beneficiary will apply the same role to another in their group. This we call chicken bank.	
11	Injected a few kinds of vaccines on chicken to very poor in revolving fund program and model farmers. They will contribute some part of it cost with CAO.	10,386 chickens
12	Injected a few kinds of vaccines on pig to very poor in revolving fund program and model farmers. They will contribute some part of it cost with CAO.	1,121 pigs
13	Castrated piglets for poor household for free and explain them how to castrate so next time they can do it by themselves.	161 piglets
14	Worked follow up, consulted and coached farmers in livestock activities at their home based.	225 families
15	Cooperated with National Biodigester Program (NBP) to support some part of Biogas to farmers who want to build biogas in Rumdoul distric of Svay Rieng. CAO and NBP join together to motivate farmer to thinks about environment and save the energy for cooking and cost.	11 Biogases
II. Poor Household Development Program		
1	Provided revolving fund without interest to poor household for chicken raising to 56 families, 2 families for duck raising, 57 families for pig raising, and 1 family for frog and we included free vaccine, coaching and working follow up.	116 laons (93 are women) with 15,900 dollars
2	Provided revolving fund without interest to poor household for rice production to 185 families, and 3 families for vegetable planting and we included technical support, coaching and follow up for free.	188 loans (167 are women) with 23,225 dollars
3	Provided revolving fund without interest to poor households for running small scale businesses.	43 loans (43 women) with 6,050 dollars
4	In 2022, there are 116 of revolving fund from animal husbandry (livestock) and 188 of revolving fund from rice production and vegetable planting (agronomy) and 43 revolving fund from small scale bussiness has been returned fund back to project.	268 revolving fund with 30,262.5 dollars

5	Currently, we have ongoing revolving fund in community has not been finish their activities there are 62 revolving fund for animal husband dry, 126 revolving for rice production and vegetable planting and 22 revolving fund for small scale bussiness. Most of them will return their fund after rice harvesting and some after selling their animal. Fund has been return lastest 6 months after providing.	210 revolving fund with 28,450 dollars
6	Monitoring and data collecting from self-help groups of women by organize group meetings to see their issue resolve on time.	16 groups (135 members) cash saving 14,379.6 dollars
III. Health and Sanitation		
1	Provided scholarships of \$ 35 / person / year to 150 poor students (Priority for single mother family and the orphans) to 7 target schools: Kampong Samrong high school, Kampong Chak high school, Pong Teuk high school, Sao Yat secondary school, Svay Chek secondary School, Thna Thnong Secondary School and Men Chey Secondary School on the 16th. Until May 20, 2022.	150 students (24 are living with single mother)
2	Supported 150 bicycles to 150 poor students (Priority for single mother family and the orphans) from 14 target primary schools in Rumduol district, Svay Rieng province. They will these bikes for their transport to school and for their parent earning money as well.	150 bicycles (39 are single mother)
3	We provided scholarships as phone card connected with internet for the poor students can join online class and explorer new thinks and resolve their study problem from intenet. We support 1\$/week/students.	2 students
4	Setting up 3 libraries in the village one in Veal, 1 in Chork, and 1 in Ta Sak village. Every library is based in student's house And we trained them to manage, promote the book and contact their friend to visit after that they can do it by themself. This program can help students in these village gain their knowledge from book reading and change their habits even their school was close at the pandimic time.	3 libraries

5	Conducted health education in communities on the topic of Covid-19 prevention, body hygiene, and dengue symptom prevention.	16 courses with 167 participants and 124 are women
6	Cooperated with Provincial Department of Women's Affairs of Svay Rieng to provided training and disseminating on domestic violence, prevention of based sexual abuse, gender and the promotion of girls' knowledge. The course was conducted in village and school.	16 courses with 377 participants and 242 are females
7	Grants supported to three primaries school for improving their infrastructure at: - Wat Thnong Primary School for repairing the gate - Wat Thmey Primary School for fencing - And Samrong Primary School for filling the school yard. These school also trying hard to collect fund from social media, friends, events and the last amount they can get from CAO. We want them to try harder before we support them.	3 schools In cash 715 dollors

1	CAO's has been raised funds through their personal Facebook to buy food (rice, fish sauce, soy sauce, seasoning, sugar, pepper and soft drink), house supplies and some cash to help the single mother or widow, the disability person, the orphans and the elderly that poor in Rumduol district, Svay Rieng province.	6 families with 532.50 dollars (4 families are single mother, 1 family is 4 single women and 1 families is disability person)
2	CAO's staffs fund by all the staff donated 1 dollars per month per staff to project.	114 dollars
